AUTHORS/RESEARCHERS, RATHER THAN GIVING AWAY ALL RIGHTS TO PUBLISHERS RETAIN THEIR COPYRIGHTS NEEDED TO ENABLE OPEN ACCESS.

In Slovenia, the law (Art. 41 of Scientific Research and Innovation Activities Act) mandates that recipients of public funds manage the copyright of their research results in accordance with the RR obligation.

SPR ENABLES
AUTHORS/RESEARCHERS

SPR is a legal presumption (Art. 41 of Scientific Research and Innovation Activities Act) that, despite bad management in publishing contracts, allows author/researcher to publish the work (publicly funded) in an open access repository (and enable its reuse).


